# 1.0 Agenda Approval

# 3.0 President's Report: Heather Johnson

- a. COBBS Criteria-After going through the selection process should there be clearer definition of our criteria to short list the students. As it stands we only have two criteria. # 6.0 COPAC: Vivian Evans
