## President Report: Josie Jaggers

#### Christmas Dance and Raffle:

The PAC discussed the 2015 Christmas Dance and Raffle. It was agreed that it was a success. The raffle did better than last year. The PAC's contribution to the raffle was a max of \$100.00 this year. It was discussed that, instead of parents bringing in a toy donation next year, that they have the option to bring in cash towards the PAC getting the stuff they need for the raffle.

The parents felt that the DJ was a success, they were able to keep the dance floor full, kept it fun, cute and family friendly. We will look at using the same service at future dance events.

#### Tanya Parent Nights:

Tanya, has organized "Building Bounce Back Kids" parent night and offered it to our parents and other PACS. It does not require registration and childcare was not advertised. Tanya would like to have two sitters for the parent night. I case parents bring their children. She has asked the PAC to cover the cost of the two sitters and some treats for the parents and host. The adults will be in the gym, there will tables and chairs set up for the parents. If children come they will be set up in Classroom 2 with a movie and some coloring activities. This event is one and half hours long on January 21, 2015. They are planning to have a sign in sheet, to be able to see how many parents came and so we will know what expect for the next one. The sign in sheet will need your name, school, and email.

The PAC agreed to spend \$50.00 towards childcare and treats for the parents and host. All agreed.

## Treasurer's Report

Andrea went over her report, there are no December bank statements yet. She was able to report that the Dance brought in 871.50 less expenses of 901.33 leaving a loss of (-29.83). Hot Lunch brought in 4069.90 + 205.65 (treats) Less 3529.39 and 678.50 (treats) making 678.66. Our general account is at 12174.02- 4767.57 (Grade 5) = 7406.40 and our gaming account is at 11, 667.74. This included talking about the school improvement planning process (since the "old" School Planning Council and SPC Report process is no longer being used in BC. For this year, we will follow the same way as last year (gather staff input at meetings with teachers and parent input at PAC meetings), but the District is in the process of developing new plan for 2016-2017.
